## Purse Gift Card/Cash Card

## Supplies:

- Pencil for tracing
- Paper scissors
- One 12 x 12 decorative memory book card stock or two pieces 8 1/2 x 11 memory book card stock (both the same or two that coordinate)
- 6" or 12" ruler
- Approximately ½" round self-stick hook and loop (Velcro). Larger sizes can be cut to size.
- Stick glue and hot glue
- Decorative items: ribbon, feathers, beads, buttons, mardi gras beads, memory book items

## Hints:

- Use stick glue, or hot glue if adding heavier items like large buttons. The handle definitely needs hot glue.
- After using stick glue, press and hold for a minute to make sure it seals.



- 1. Cut out paper patterns on solid lines. If you plan on making more, I would create a pattern on cardstock.
- 2. Trace patterns onto back of decorative card stock. Note: not suitable for one-way patterned card stock.
- 3. Fold pattern where indicated. Use a ruler to help make a straight fold.
- 4. Envelope Use glue stick to glue sides together to make an envelope. Use Velcro to have an envelope flap that you can open and close. Use glue stick to glue envelope to inside center piece of purse.
- 5. Decorate purse to your liking.
  - a. Use a glue stick to glue piece of ribbon across top outside of purse. Fold ends to back of card and glue.
  - b. Add other decorative elements to top outside of purse.
  - c. Glue decorative elements to bottom inside of purse.
  - d. Optional: write a note or use a rubber stamp.
- 6. Attach self-stick Velcro pieces to top inside of purse and to bottom outside of purse, so you can open and close your purse.
- 7. Hot glue your beaded handle to top of middle purse pattern on outside.
