

Georgia

This block has also been around a long time but usually is 10 inches and we are doing 9 inch blocks. I've resized it for us. All the squares are normally the same size but I cut the middle row and column down to 1 inch finished, leaving the rest 2 inches finished to make our 9 inch finished block easier.

Supplies -

4 white 2 1/2 x 1 1/2 inch rectangles

4 white 2 1/2 inch squares

2 red 2 7/8 inch squares

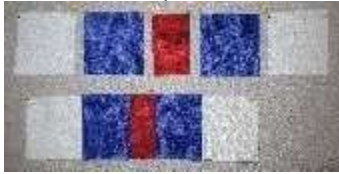
2 blue 2 7/8 inch squares

8 blue 2 1/2 inch squares

1 blue 1 1/2 inch square

4 red 2 1/2 x 1 1/2 inch rectangles

Sew the top and bottom rows - white 2 1/2 sq, blue 2 1/2 sq, red 2 1/2 x 1 1/2 rectangle, blue 2 1/2 sq and white 2 1/2 square. Press.



Draw diagonal lines on the red 2 7/8 inch squares. Put them together with the blue 2 7/8 inch squares. Sew 1/4 inch off that line on both sides of that line. Cut on the line and press open to make 4 half square triangles.

Sew the next 2 rows together - blue 2 1/2 in sq, red/blue half square triangle with the blue in the upper left corner, white 2 1/2 x 1/2 rectangle, blue/red half square triangle with the blue in the upper right corner and finally another blue 2 1/2 sq.



Sew middle row with remaining red and white rectangles and the blue 1 1/2 inch square.



Sew your rows together.
