

## SEPT BLOCK - WONDER LAKE

Light - Cut 1 square at  $6 \frac{7}{8}$  inches, cut once on the diagonal

Cut 1 square at  $5 \frac{3}{8}$  inches, cut once on the diagonal

Cut 1 square at 3 inches, cut once on the diagonal. We will only be using 1 of these pieces.

Cut 3 pieces at  $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$  inches. For scrappy need 3 different fabrics.

Cut 6 pieces at 2 inch square. If doing scrappy need 3 sets of 2 pieces of the same fabric.

Dark - Cut 1 square at  $6 \frac{7}{8}$  inches, cut once on the diagonal

Cut 1 square at  $5 \frac{3}{8}$  inches, cut once on the diagonal.

Cut 1 square at 3 inches, cut once on the diagonal. We will only need 1 of these pieces.

Cut 3 pieces at  $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$  inches. For scrappy you need 3 different fabrics

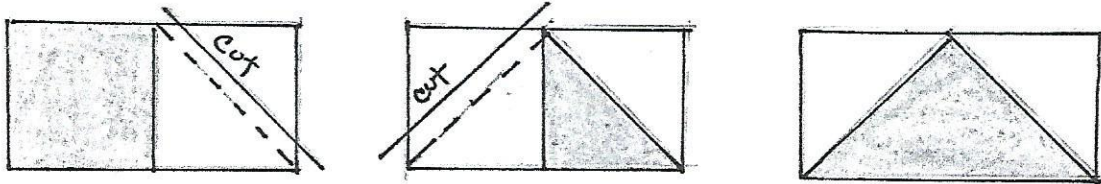
Cut 6 pieces at 2 inch square. If doing scrappy need 3 sets of 2 pieces the same fabric.

### Sewing

Flying Geese units place a light 2 inch square on the right side of the dark  $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$  inch piece. Sew from center top to bottom right corner. See diagram. Trim and press.

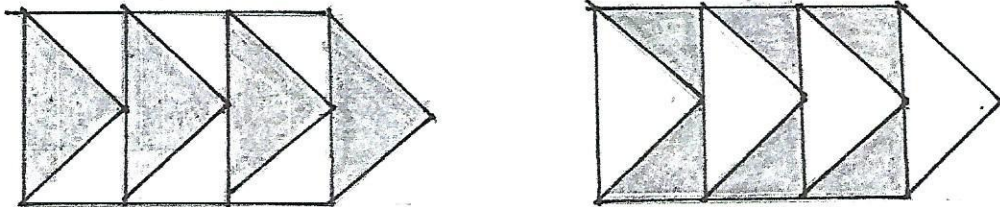
Place same fabric square on top of the unit you just made. This time on the left side. Sew from the top center to bottom left corner. See diagram

Need to make 3 with light Geese and dark sky and 3 with dark Geese and light sky.



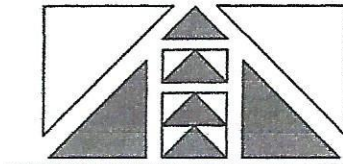
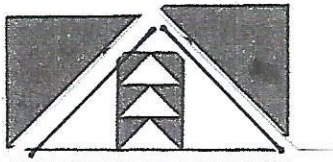
Sew the 3 with light geese units together. Add the light triangle to the top. See diagram.

Repeat with the dark geese units



Sew the dark triangles you made with the  $5 \frac{3}{8}$  inch square to the flying Gees unit. See diagram

Repeat with the light triangles to the dark Flying geese unit.



Sew the light triangles you made with the  $6 \frac{7}{8}$  inch square to unit with the dark Flying Geese unit and the dark triangles to the light Flying Geese unit. Sew the 2 pieces together.
