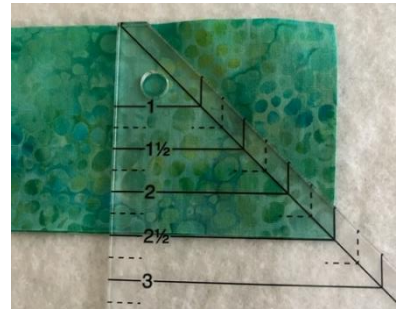
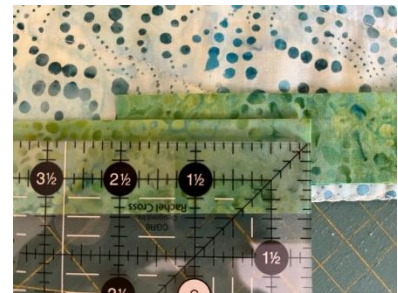


Using the Folded Corner Clipper for Bindings

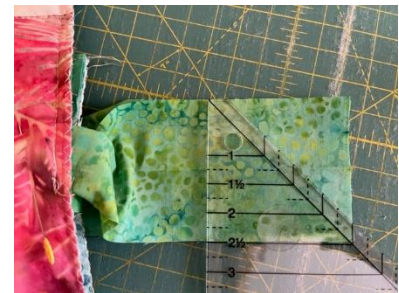
- With all binding strips **RIGHT SIDES UP**, align the Folded Corner Clipper to your binding width. In the picture the width of the binding is 2 ½ inches. Trim this edge.



- Place two pieces right side together as shown and sew ¼ inch from the slanted edge. The seam should go through the notches in the fabric. Press the seam open for less bulk.



- **Ending your binding:** Leave a large space between where you started to apply the binding and where you end the binding. You will need to join the two ends of the bindings. There should be an overlap from the two sections equal to the width of the bindings as shown above. This binding is 2 ½ inches wide.
- Pin your quilt so that one binding is on the top of the other, **RIGHT SIDES UP**. Align the two edges as shown in the picture. Trim the edge and pin the two sections to keep them aligned. Sew using a ¼ inch seam. Then continue to sew your binding to your quilt using the ¼ inch seam.



Below are pictures of the front and back of your binding if you did your binding completely by machine.
