

Road to Oklahoma

The Road to Oklahoma block has been around a long time and can be found on several sites including www.quilterscache.com where it is shown as a 12 inch block as it is in all the other locations I found. Once again, the instructions are good but the measurements have to be changed for our 9 inch block.

Supplies -

4 corners - 3 blue $2\frac{3}{4}$ inch squares and 1 red $2\frac{3}{4}$ in square

center - 2 white, 1 blue and 1 red $2\frac{3}{4}$ in squares

sides - 4 white $2\frac{3}{4} \times 5$ in rectangles

4 blue $2\frac{3}{4}$ in squares

Sides - Mark a diagonal line on the 4 blue squares. Place them right side down on the ends of the white rectangles with 2 pointing in one direction and pointing in the other. Sew on the line. Press and trim the excess fabric from the back.



Make a 4 patch using the red, white and remaining blue $2\frac{3}{4}$ in squares.



Construct the block as shown being careful that you have the sides pointing in the right direction.
