

## Michigan - Michigan Block

This block can be found on public domain sites. It's usually a 12 inch block so this one is resized to the 9 inches we are using - very easy since it is basically a 9 patch. Another possibility for Michigan would have been a lighthouse block because Michigan has more lighthouses than any other state.

Cutting -

- 2 red  $2\frac{3}{8}$  inch squares
- 4 white  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares for the corners
- 1 white  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inch square cut into twice diagonally for 4 pieces
- 2 different white  $2\frac{3}{8}$  inch squares cut once diagonally
- 1 blue  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inch square for center
- 1 blue  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inch square cut twice diagonally
- 1 different blue  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inch square cut twice diagonally

Construction -

1 - Pair the pieces from the red and white  $2\frac{3}{4}$  inch square and sew together. Add one of the blues.



2 - Sew pairs of white and the other blue together.



3 - Sew one of number 1 and one of number 2 together into  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares.



4 - Layout all pieces in a 9 patch and sew together.
