

Dec. - BLACK SPRUCE

Light fabric - Cut 1 piece at 6 7/8 inches. Cut on the diagonal once. Piece A
 Cut 1 piece at 4 7/8 inches. Cut on the diagonal once. Piece B
 Cut 2 pieces at 2 1/2 X 4 1/2 inches. Piece C

Light medium fabric - Cut 3 pieces at 2 1/2 inches. Piece D
 Cut 1 piece at 2 1/2 X 4 1/2 inches. Piece e

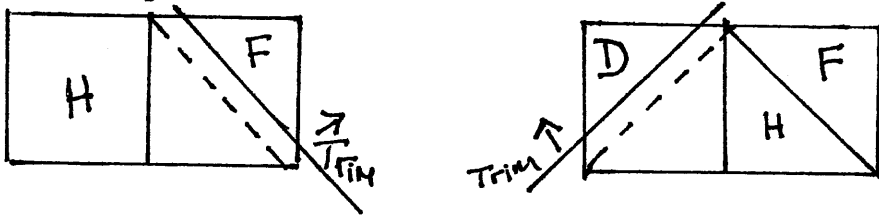
Dark medium fabric - Cut 3 pieces at 2 1/2 inches. Piece F
 Cut 1 piece at 2 1/2 x 4 1/2 inches. Piece G

Dark fabric- Cut 4 pieces at 2 1/ X 4 1/2 inches. Piece H
 Cut 2 pieces at 4 7/8 inches. Cut on the diagonal once. Piece I

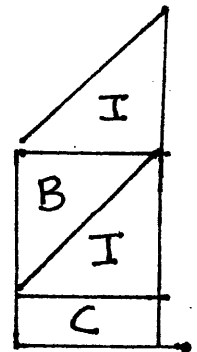
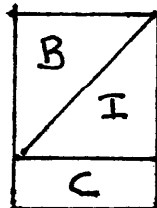
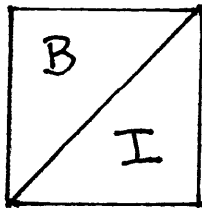
Sewing

Take 3 of the piece H and place piece F on top right side of piece H. sew on the diagonal line from top center to bottom right corner. Make 3 units.

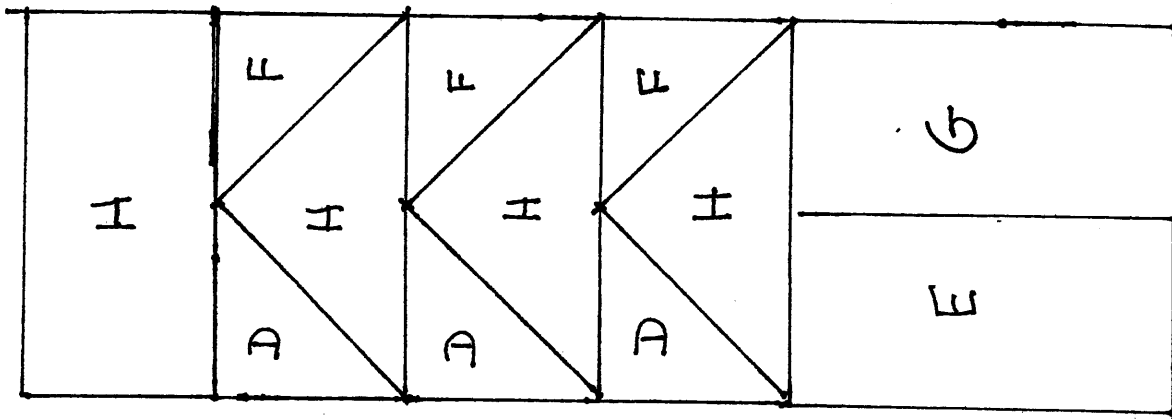
Place a piece D on left side of unit you just made and sew from top center to bottom left corner. Make 3.
 You should have 3 Flying Geese unit with light med. On left side and dark med. On the right side.
 See diagram.



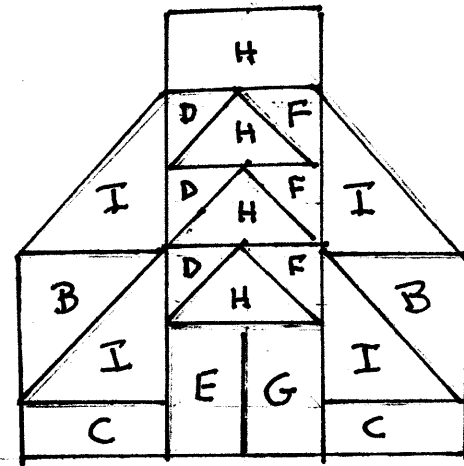
Take 2 piece B and sew them to a piece I to make a half square triangle.
 Sew piece C to bottom of the unit you just made using the diagram for placement.
 Sew the remaining piece I to top of the unit you just made. See diagram for placement.



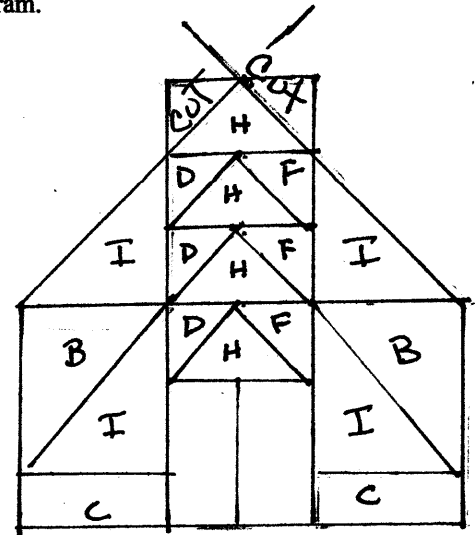
Sew the 3 flying Geese together one on top of the other.
 Sew piece E and piece G together along the long side. Sew this to the flying Gees units at the bottom of the units. See diagram. Sew the remaining piece H to the top of the unit. We will be trimming it later.



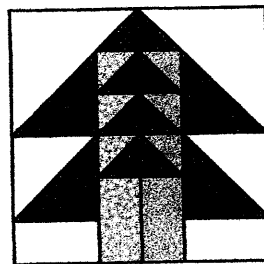
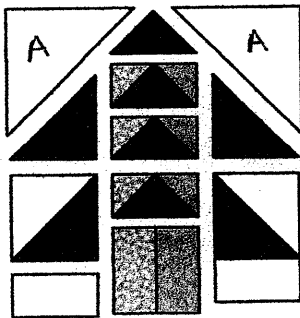
Sew the half square triangle units to either side of the Flying Geese units.
See diagram for placement.



Mark a center dot in the top piece H.
Carefully using the center dot and the triangle unit trim up the unit. See diagram.



Sew piece a to either side of the unit you just cut.

Fabrics

Setting Triangles and squares 2 1/2 yards

Inner Border 2/3 yards

Outer Border and Binding 2 1/2 yards

Cutting

Setting triangles and squares

Cut 3 squares @ 18 1/4 inches, cut on the diagonal twice to make 4 triangles these will be the set in triangles.

Cut 2 squares @ 9 3/8 inches, cut on the diagonal once to make corner triangles.

Cut 6 squares @ 12 1/2 inches.

Inner border cut 8 strips @ 2 1/2 inches.

Outer Borders and Binding will be cut on the length of grain.

Cut 4 strips @ 5 1/2 inches

Cut 4 strips @ 2 1/2 inches.

We will be sewing the rows on the diagonal.

Layout your blocks on point in a layout that you like. We are using the setting squares between our blocks.

Place a setting triangle at the end of each row. See diagram on other side of the page..

Placing the corners triangles in the proper position.

Add the inner borders. Adding the sides first than the top and bottom.

Add the outer Borders adding the sides first than the top and bottom.

STRAIGHT SET FOR BLOCK OF THE MONTH GSQ 2018

Finished size 54 X 68

Fabrics- Sashing fabric $\frac{3}{4}$ yard
Cornerstone fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ yard
Border and Binding 2 yards

Cutting

Sashing cut 2 strips @ $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches, sub cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ X $12\frac{1}{2}$ inch pieces. Need 31 pieces.

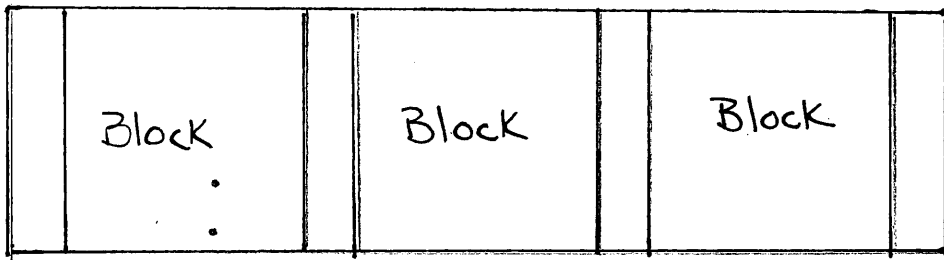
Cornerstones cut 2 strips @ $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches, sub cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares. Need 20 pieces.

Border and Binding will be cut on the length of grain.

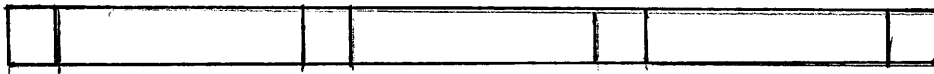
Borders cut 4 strips @ $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches and Binding cut 4 Strips we allowed for up $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips.

Lay out your blocks in a 3 by 4 layout. With 3 blocks across and 4 blocks down.

Using the diagram below sew your rows across with sashing strips between all the blocks.



Sew 5 sashing strip with cornerstones between then to create the sashing between the block rows.
