

Casserole Carrier

This carrier is perfect for round or square casserole dishes, where most are made for rectangles.

Supplies-

Cut 2 - 20 inch squares of fabric - matching or coordinates

Cut 1 - 2 1/2 inch by width of fabric piece for strap and D Links.

Cut 1 - 20 inch square of heatproof batting like Insulbright

Need 2 D links

Matching or coordinating thread

Working sewing machine with manual

Regular sewing supplies

Directions-

- 1- Fold strap fabric right sides together and stitch the long side.
- 2- Turn right side out and press.
- 3- Lay the lining fabric on your table, right side up.
- 4- Place the strap diagonally across the lining. Cut strap to the correct length. Pin each end of the strap in place.
- 5- From leftover, cut 2 pieces 5 - 6 inches long and thread a D link on each one. Fold in half with the D link towards the middle and pin on the remaining corner.
- 6- Layer fabric and batting - first Place the lining right side up, next the outside fabric right side down, batting on the top.
- 7- Trim each corner diagonally (including the strap pieces) leaving about a 2 inch diagonal cut.
- 8- Stitch three layers around the edges, leaving a 2-3 inches for opening to turn it.
- 9- Turn and press. Top stitch if desired. All done!
