

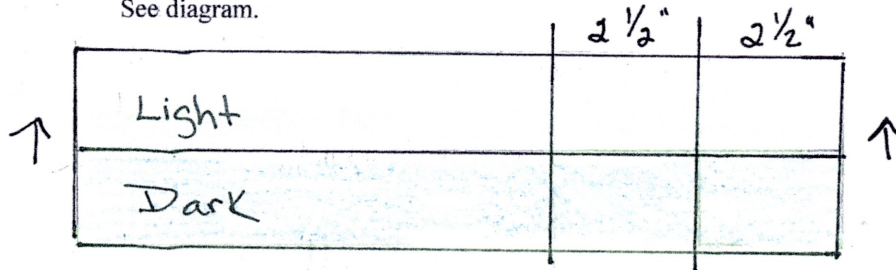
## APRIL - MAPLE STAR

Cut from Dark fabric 1 piece at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X 12 inches  
8 pieces at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square

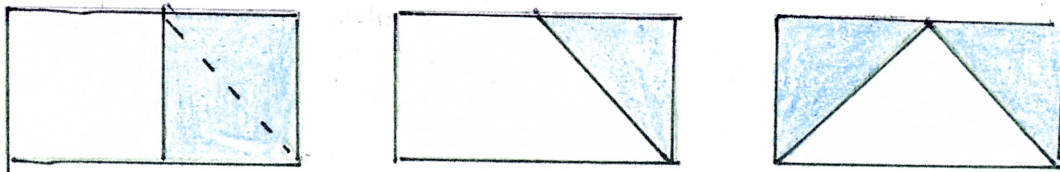
Cut from medium fabric 4 pieces at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches

Cut from light fabric 1 piece at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 12 inches  
8 pieces at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches  
1 piece at  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inch square

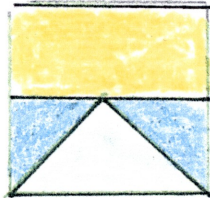
Take the 2 pieces that are  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X 10 inches and sew the together along the long side.  
Piece should now be  $4\frac{1}{2}$  x 10 inches. Press towards the light. Sub cut into 4 pieces at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

Take 4 pieces of light fabric that are  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ . Using these make 4 Flying Geese blocks using sew and flip. Do this by placing a dark  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch square on right side and sewing from center top to right bottom. Trim and press. Repeat on left side sewing from top center to bottom left corner. Trim and press.  
See diagrams below for steps.



Sew a medium piece to top of each Flying Geese block. See diagram.



Sew a light piece at  $2\frac{1}{2}$  X  $4\frac{1}{2}$  to each of the 2 patch unit you first made using the block layout for placement.

Sew block together using the block layout below.
