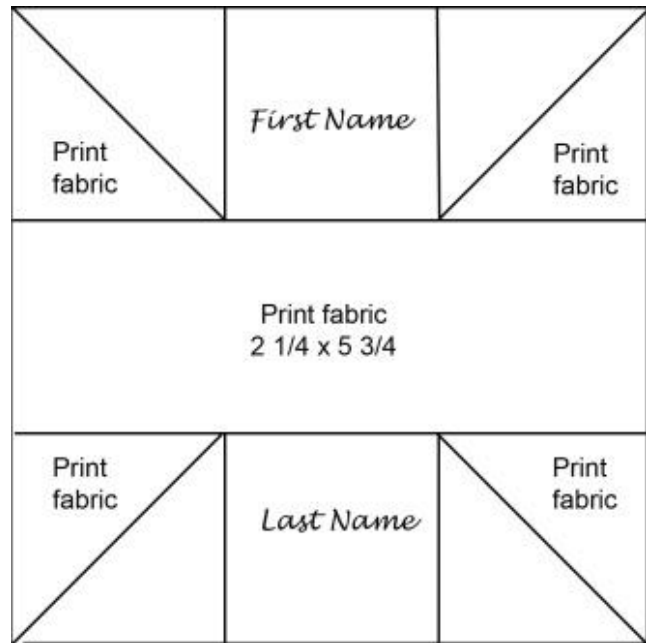
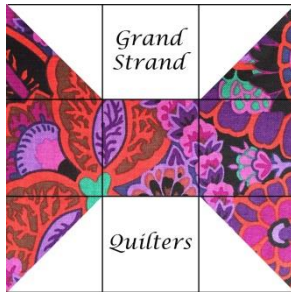


Grand Strand Quilter's

Name Tag



From print fabric cut

- Two $3 \frac{3}{4}$ inch squares
- One $5 \frac{3}{4}$ by $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inch rectangle
- One 6 by 6 inch square for back (any fabric)
- About 30 inches by $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inches for binding
- About 30 inches by $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches for a strap

From white or background fabric cut

- Two $3 \frac{3}{4}$ inch squares
- Two $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inch squares. You might want to add your name to these squares before you begin.

Construct Corner Blocks

- Place one of the $3 \frac{3}{4}$ inch fabric squares right sides facing to the background fabric.
- Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner.
- Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from each side of the line
- Cut apart on the line to get two half square triangle blocks, pressing seams to the print
- Repeat process for the other $3 \frac{3}{4}$ squares and trim your four squares to $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inches.

Assemble

- Top row: Half square triangle block, $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inch background square with first name, half square triangle block. Use care for proper orientation for the blocks and your name.
- Middle row: print rectangle
- Bottom row: repeat instructions for the top row
- Trim to $5 \frac{3}{4}$ inch square
- Add batting and backing and quilt as desired.
- Bind, add strap, add your name if not there already, and wear proudly.
